

# ALTADENA TOWN COUNCIL

TRAFFIC COMMITTEE REPORT

August 18, 2009

The Traffic Committee met on August 03, 2009.

County of Los Angeles Representative Jalaine Madrid attended the meeting to discuss pending items.

## **CHP Activities**

CHP Officer Miller attended the Traffic Committee meeting and participated in the discussions.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

**Windsor Avenue Road Restriping** – The County and the City of Pasadena have approved the re-striping plan for Winsor. The neighborhood has been notified of the change. The plan includes a center two way turn lane between Woodbury Road and Ventura Street. The plan is scheduled for implementation in December 2009

**Southbound Left Turn Signal on Winsor at Woodbury.** – The modification to the traffic signal to install a separate left turn signal for the southbound direction has been approved by the County and it is scheduled to be implemented by the end of 2009.

**Santa Rosa north of Mariposa** – A complaint of speeding and no sidewalks is under study. Santa Rosa has too much traffic to install speed humps; however, other options are under study, including posting at 25 MPH with radar enforcement.

**Speeding on Pepper Drive.** – The speeding issue has been resolved. An Engineering and Traffic study was completed which is good until 2011. The street can be enforced by radar.

**Speeding on Various Streets** – Speed signage and radar enforcement signage will be installed on Winsor, Woodbury, Allen and Hill at the town limits.

**Accidents at Altadena and Santa Rosa** – Traffic volumes do not warrant a four way stop at this location. The County will have foliage cut back that currently blocks driver sight for the southbound direction.

**Request to Remove Street Sweeping Signs on West Terrace Street** – This request is currently under study.

**Speeding on Vistillis Road near Allen** – County is awaiting a petition from residents for speed controls.

**Parking on Boston Street near Holliston** – County is awaiting a petition from residents for parking controls.
